



FORM AND INFORMATION - FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL UNDER GRAMA

NOTE: This form and information sheet applies to records requests involving the Utah Department of Commerce and its various offices and divisions. Under the Government Records Access and Management Act (GRAMA), you may appeal the denial or partial denial of a records request or the denial of a fee waiver, or may contest a claim of extraordinary circumstances. Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-401.

- **Written Notice of Appeal:** You may use this form, or you may send a letter or an email providing the information on this form.
- **Chief Administrative Officer:** The Department Executive Director is the chief administrative officer responsible for reviewing a GRAMA appeal.
- **Appeal Due Date:** Your appeal shall be filed **no later than 30 days** after the date your records request or fee waiver was denied, or 30 days after notification of a claim of extraordinary circumstances.
- **Appeal Submission:** You may submit your GRAMA appeal by email to CommerceAppeals@utah.gov, or may hand-deliver or mail your GRAMA appeal, addressed as follows:
